

## DISCUSSION

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John L. Czajka blends the issues of sampling and missing data in his paper, "Predicting Edit Outcomes: The Strategic Use of Imputation in Estimating Corporate Income Statistics." His concern is the validity of small domain estimates when missing data strategies usually employed for nonresponse are used as estimators following a sampling operation. The central issue is whether missing data adjustments should be based on information from other domains or only each specific domain in question. The general theme of the paper appears to be to compro-

mise between these options. His paper details the concern with the previous method for small domain estimates. A complete evaluation of the proposed alternatives will be an excellent topic for a future paper. Overall, the presentation is thoughtful and inventive.
