- Expand and refine data to measure equity and capture the diversity of the U.S. population



IRS-Census Race & Ethnicity Data File

Collaborative research project with the Census Bureau that seeks to obtain disclosure-protected race and ethnicity data by linking IRS administrative records with the Bureau's Best Race file.

IRS delivers updated microdata file covering over 436 million individuals	02/15/2024
