# Modernization Goals

## Goals to Modernize and Improve Tax Stats:

- Increase graphics to make our webpages more engaging, attract new customers, and engage current customers who are less data savvy.
- Improve information architecture and page design so information is presented in an intuitive way that improves navigability and enables users to more easily find information.
- Increase data visualizations and add APIs (Application Programming Interfaces) so more advanced users can leverage our data.
- Explore distinctive branding to strengthen the SOI brand as a federal statistical agency.
- Improve engagement internally with Subject Matter Experts to ensure that our modernization efforts are continually reviewed and improved.
- Engage our most trusted customers for continual feedback to make ongoing improvements.

- Research other federal statistical agencies' webpages for visual feedback to point to specific elements (such as buttons, layout, images) that may be incorporated into our webpages.

# Modernization Project Phases

## Modernization Phases

**Phase 1:** Standardize a web layout that may be utilized across various subject matter webpages.

- Begin with Projections webpages.
- Plan to incorporate a similar layout for other Tax Stats webpages.

**Phase 2:** Improve how we organize and present research articles.

- Determine frequency and format for SOI Bulletin articles.
- Upgrade presentation of other research publications, such as the IRS Research Bulletin and Working Papers.

**Phase 3 (part 1):** Update our Individuals Income Tax Statistics and Corporations Income Tax Statistics Complete Report webpages.

- Implement improvements, such as congruent layouts.
- Add static data visualizations.

**Phase 3 (part 2):** Engage SOI employees on new webpage updates to ensure accuracy and timeliness.

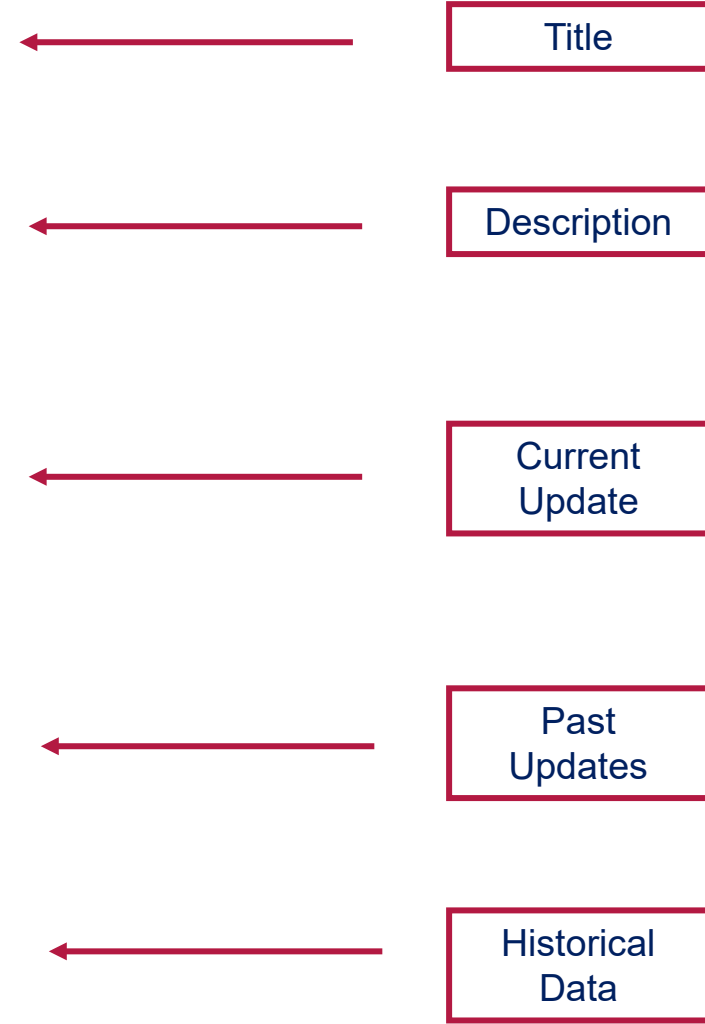
