Find answers to your tax questions when you need them with the Interactive Tax
Assistant on IRS.gov. The ITA guides you through a series of questions and provides answers for you immediately on a variety of tax law topics. The most common questions asked are:

- Do I Need to File a Return?
- What is My Filing Status?
- Who Can I Claim as a Dependent?
- How Much is My Standard Deduction?
- Am I Eligible to Claim an Education Credit?

There are 30 topics to choose from and we've recently added five new topics to the ITA:

- Do I qualify for the Retirement Savings Contributions Credit?
- Is my tip income taxable?
- <u>Do I include my scholarship, fellowship, or education grant as income on my tax</u> return?
- Can I deduct personal taxes that I pay as an itemized deduction On Schedule A?
- Am I eligible for the Child and Dependent Care Credit?
